



WAYNE WELLS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Wayne Wells Memorial Scholarship is available to current AFOA Alberta members who are pursuing their Certified Aboriginal Financial Manager Certificate or Diploma or other post-secondary program in management (including finance, human resources, accounting or related field) in a program that is sponsored, offered jointly or approved by AFOA Alberta. The program must lead to a certificate, diploma or bachelor degree in Alberta. The scholarship is available to aboriginal members and is based on financial need. The scholarship is provided for tuition and or travel, including, meal allowances and paid accommodations subject to maximums. Funds are not available for the use of personal accommodations. The maximum paid on an annual basis is \$750.00. The actual value of the scholarship is based on the demonstrated need and may be less than the maximum. Scholarship may be applied directly to tuition or paid to third party for associated program costs.
